## Information on Written Forms of Examination in Winter Semester 2020/21 at the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering

The Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering offers the following formats for written examinations in winter semester 2020/21:

- examinations in presence on campus for small groups and in compliance with the extensive hygiene concept (students' duty to cooperate)
- electronic practical credit requirement (not supervised), no presence alternative.
- Supervised online examination with additional presence alternative

If more than approximately 40 students register for an examination in presence, the examination will be postponed. Students who wish to write an examination in presence do not need to submit reasons for this. If this should be requested in individual cases, please contact the Student Services Office ([studiendekan@ei.tum.de](mailto:studiendekan@ei.tum.de)).

Please note in case of technical problems:

In the event that an online examination cannot be executed or has to be interrupted, this examination will not be counted (§9 BayFEV). This applies to all candidates of the examination, provided that a general technical or other malfunction occurs which is immediately reported to the examiner and the respective Examination Board. In these cases, after an assessment and decision by the respective Examination Board, the examination will not be counted or a withdrawal with an acknowledged reason will be granted (§13a APSO). Please also note that you are required to claim instantly any technical malfunctions that may occur during an online examination.
